MINUTES OF THE VIRTUAL MEETING OF RESEARCH ADVISORY COMMITTEE (RAC) OF AERCs/Us HELD ON MAY 28TH, 2021

The third meeting of Research Advisory Committee (RAC) was virtually conducted under the Chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Agarwal, Secretary (DAC&FW) on 28.05.2021 at 4 P.M. The mandate of the RAC is to assign research work, set targets for Agro Economics Research Centres/Units (AERCs/Us) and carry out performance-review periodically. The list of participants in the meeting is **at Annexure-I**.

- 2. The meeting began with a brief welcome note by Mr. B.L. Meena, Adviser (AER Division) and Member Secretary, RAC welcoming the Chairman, RAC and other participants of the meeting. The Member Secretary then invited Dr. P. Babu, Assistant Director (AER Division) to make a brief presentation on the AER Scheme and RAC. Dr. P. Babu presented before the Committee an overview of the AER Scheme and the RAC and its objectives. Further, Dr. Babu presented on the two Agenda points of the meeting.
 - Agenda Item No. 1: Review of Work Progress and Outcome of AERCs/Us
 Dr. P. Babu apprised the Committee about the status of the studies at hand and the studies completed by AER Network over the course of last two years for the Work Plan of 2019-20.
 - Agenda Item 2: Approval for new studies to be undertaken by AERCs/Us for the year 2021-22
 - Dr. P. Babu then informed the Committee about the new study proposals received from various Divisions of DAC&FW, allied Ministries, AERC/Us and ICAR among others.
- **3.** The Secretary (DAC&FW) stressed on the importance of Agro-economic Research studies in the arena of policy making.
- 4. The RAC approved in total 17 All-India and state-specific research topics for Work-Plan 2021- 22 after careful examination of the need, objectives and implementation avenues of all the proposed studies. Further, some study topics need to be referred to the concerned Divisions for comments/clarification/justification. The list of study proposal-wise comments by the RAC is placed at Annexure II.

While discussing Study Proposal No. 2 on 'Assessment of Skill Development Gap for different Agro-Climatic Zones in the area of Agricultural Mechanization', Additional Secretary, Department of Water Resources pointed out that the Water use efficiency aspect may be added in the study to which Secretary (DACFW) suggested to send a ToR for a separate study to be conducted by AERC/Us.

It was also discussed that since the Study Proposals received from ICAR were mainly for funding purpose for which there is no provision in the AERC Scheme of DES/DAC&FW, ICAR is to be informed about the existing provisions of allocating studies to AER Centre/Units and the method by which studies get conducted in AER Division, DES. In case, there is any particular study that is of relevance to both ICAR and DAC&FW, they may send an appropriate study proposal that will be considered at the next RAC meeting.

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
