

(*Polyphagotarsonemus latus*) is the major pests while mealy bug (*Phenacoccus solenopsis*) is minor pest. But since last two years (2012 and 2013) Grey weevil (*Mylocerus discolour* Boehemam) (also called as ace weevil) is emerging as new pest. This is one of the minor pest in some of the jute growing area and it was completely absent in this region. But now we are observing it since last three years with its increasing population trend. This may be attributed to changing climatic conditions of the region.



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An economic analysis of production and marketing of potato and onion crops in Rewa, district of Madhya Pradesh

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Abstract

Potato and onion are most important commercial vegetable crops grown worldwide. Including India. In Baghelkhand region of Madhya Pradesh in India. It as great demand both in over country as well as in outer world. The highest productivity of onion in world is of Korea, respectively (67.25 mt/ha). Potato is use as vegetable and onion is uses as spice. . The potato and onion producing farmers were then categorized as small (>2 ha.) ,medium (2 to 4 ha.) and large (above 4 to 10 ha.), based on land holding size of the farmers ,20 farmers. from each selected village were selected randomly among three size groups according to proportional allocation technique. Stratified random sample procedure was adopted for the selection of villages and farmers. The number of small size farms were equal compared to medium and higher to large size farms but there was reverse relation so far as operational area was concerned. The present investigation was carried out during rabi session of 2012-13. At Rewa, district of Madhya Pradesh .department of agricultural Economics & Farm Management, College of Agriculture, Rewa. Factors having higher elasticity of production value would be looked after carefully and increase their input level for securing a higher return. Efficient marketing should be followed for securing higher share of producer in consumers paid price. Quality product attract higher unit price, therefore, proper grading and cleaning of the potato and onion should be done at producer level to increase the income of the producer in marketing of the product. Input supply centers should be established at mandi level so that the producers do not have difficulty in purchasing of that inputs at reasonable price.
